As you are aware, the 'National Overseas Scholarship' Scheme is being implemented by the Department of Social Justice and Empowerment as a Central Sector Scheme for educational empowerment and socio-economic development of students from disadvantaged sections of the society. This Scheme supports low-income students belonging to the Scheduled Castes, De-notified Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes, Landless Agricultural Labourers and Traditional Artisans communities to pursue higher education in top 500 QS World University ranking Educational Institutions abroad for Masters or Ph.D degrees. Every year 125 fresh awards are being given under this Scheme with a cap of 10% of the total slots for each State/ UT. A copy of the Scheme Guidelines for Selection Year 2026-27 is enclosed herewith for your ready reference.

In order to fill the slots, the NOS portal (<https://nosmsje.gov.in>) is currently open for receiving applications for the 'First Round of Selection Year 2026-27' from 24th April 2026 to 02nd June 2026. Thereafter, the portal shall be opened again for 4 days from 04th June 2026 to 07th June 2026 to allow the candidates who have already submitted their applications to make corrections/editing, if any, in the submitted applications.

3. You are requested to issue instructions and guidance to concerned authority at the State, District, Block and Educational Institution level to create wider awareness about this Scheme and to arrange contextually appropriate hand holding support to facilitate eligible, suitable and willing students of institutions of your State/ UT to complete the application formalities before the due date of 02.06.2026.
